REPORT ON: "SAFE HANDS" – WORKSHOP ON INFECTION CONTROL

There were in total 04 Skill Stations divided among 115 nursing students each consisting of a group of 30 students set at each skill station. The Skill Station consisted of Hand Rub-Hand Wash, Biomedical Waste Management, Needle Stick Injury, Blood Spill Management and Personal Protective Equipment.
