

## **Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) College of Nursing, Pune**

### **Report Student Satisfaction Survey 2019-20**

The student satisfaction survey was conducted for all the courses i.e. Bachelor's of Nursing, Post Basic B.Sc Nursing and Master's of Nursing, PhD and General Nursing Midwifery at College of Nursing, Pune.

The total students in Diploma, undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD who participated in the survey were 430 the total strength of all the students is 522.

#### **I] Curriculum**

##### **1. Orientation Programme**

As per the curriculum under the heading of orientation programme 178 students rated it as excellent, 200 rated it as good, 34 students rated it as satisfactory and 16 students rated average and 2 of them said it is poor.

##### **2. Introduction to curriculum**

158 rated it as excellent, 217 students rated it as good 40 felt it was satisfactory 13 students rated average and 2 students rated it as poor.

##### **3. Rules and regulations with regards to internal assessment, examinations**

174 students rated it as excellent, 196 rated it as good, 38 students rated it as satisfactory and 20 students rated average and 2 students felt it was poor.

#### **II Teaching Learning**

##### **4. Communication skills**

194 students rated it as excellent, 195 rated it as good, 30 students rated it as satisfactory and 11 of them felt it was average.

##### **5. Approach to teaching**

189 students rated it as excellent, 198 rated it as good, 30 of them felt it was satisfactory, 10 of them thought it was average.

##### **6. Use of ICT (LCD, ppt, videos, online resources etc. ) in teaching learning**

184 students rated it as excellent, 189 rated it as good, 39 students rated it as satisfactory and 18 students rated average.

##### **7. Overall Teaching Quality**

202 students rated it as excellent, 187 rated it as good, 27 felt it was satisfactory and 14 said it was average.

##### **8. Paper discussion done after exam in the class**

227 students rated it as always, 126 rated it as usually, 54 of them said it some departments and 23 of them rated it as rarely

### **9. Teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications**

260 students rated it as always, 132 rated it as usually, 28 thought it was done occasionally and 10 of them felt it was rarely done.

### **10. College conduct remedial classes**

190 students rated it as Always, 169 of them rated it as usually and 47 students rated it as occasionally 24 of them felt it was rarely conducted.

### **11. Teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem based learning for enhancing learning experiences.**

249 students rated it as Always, 132 of them rated it as usually, 37 said it was occasionally used and 12 of them rated it as rarely.

### **12. Teachers encourage you to express and clarify your doubts in class**

331 students rated it as Always, 71 of them rated it as usually, 16 Of them felt it was done occasionally and 12 of them rated it as rarely

### **Three observations / suggestions to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in the institution.**

1. Remedial classes to be conducted
2. Online resources can be added and ICT facilities can be strengthened.
3. Need to focus on student preparation keeping in view of the competitive examination.

## **III. Infrastructure**

### **13. Rate lecture theatres of your college (with regards to A-V aids, acoustics, smart boards etc.)**

146 students rated it as excellent, 215 rated it as good, 46 students rated it as satisfactory and 23 students rated average.

### **14. Rate facilities in demonstration rooms/practical hall/laboratories**

147 students rated it as excellent, 193 rated it as good, 72 students rated it as satisfactory and 18 students rated average.

### **15. Rate central library and reading hall infrastructure**

139 students rated it as excellent, 211 rated it as good, 57 rated as satisfactory and 23 rated as average.

### **16. Rate facilities of book issue timings, reference section, reading hall timings, Xerox facility etc**

115 students rated it as excellent, 204 rated it as good, 74 students rated it as satisfactory and 37 rated it as average.

### **17. Rate Digital library- internet, computers, e-journals/e-references**

96 students rated it as excellent, 205 rated it as good, 82 students rated it as satisfactory , 47 said it is average.

### **18. Rate the canteen (infrastructure, food quality, hygiene etc.)**

83 students rated it as excellent, 184 rated it as good, 95 students rated it as satisfactory and 68 students rated average.

### **Give three observations / suggestions to improve the infrastructure/facilities in your institution.**

1. Space constrains the building is not per the Indian Nursing Council norms.
2. Nursing College does not have its own canteen, though hospital canteen and other canteens in the campus are available.
3. Conference hall or a multipurpose hall to be extended as the existing one cannot house the total number of students.

## **IV. Research**

### **19. Were adequate opportunities provided to students for research projects?**

371 students agreed that adequate opportunities are provided to them while 31 of them felt that it was not given.

### **20. Were funds granted by University/ College for research ?**

230 students said that funds were provided, whereas 200 said that No funds are granted by University/ College for research

### **21. Were funds granted by College for presenting research in conferences?**

257 students answered yes whereas 173 said that No funds are granted by the College for presenting research in conferences.

### **22. Were interested students encouraged or motivated to participate in quiz, workshops, debates, conferences etc.?**

All 412 students agreed that they are encouraged and motivated to participate in quiz, workshops, debates, conferences etc whereas 18 of them said no

### **Two/three relevant observations about research opportunities.**

1. Funds to be provided for students from college for research projects.
2. Adequate time to be provided to conduct the research projects.

## **V. Student Support**

### **23. Student Mentor/ Ward teacher system**

165 students rated it as excellent, 197 rated it as good, 48 students rated it as satisfactory, 12 said it was average and 8 of them felt it was poor.

#### **24. Student counselling cell**

165 students rated it as excellent, 210 rated it as good, 36 rated it as satisfactory, 15 rated as poor & 4 rated as poor

#### **25. Grievance Redressal system**

148 students rated it as excellent, 215 rated it as good, 44 students rated it as satisfactory and 23 as average.

#### **26. Basic health services centre**

166 students rated it as excellent, 202 rated it as good , 41 rated as satisfactory & 21 rated as average.

#### **27. Are students encouraged to participate in cultural activities/ events in college or outside?**

415 students agreed that they are encouraged to participate in cultural activities/ events in college as well as outside whereas 15 of them said no.

#### **28. Are students encouraged to participate in sports activities/ events in college or outside?**

413 students agreed that they are encouraged to participate in sports activities/ events in college as well as outside and 17 answered no.

#### **Two/three observations about student support**

- 1. Faculty members are approachable and available whenever required.**
- 2. Basic health facilities are available but needs more support in terms of finances.**
